My correspondent complains that SI is not skeptical enough: that it concentrates on comparatively harmless pseudoscience while it tolerates dangerous nonsense, among which he cites forensic psychiatry and the S.D.I.

I believe Dr Whitney has a point. For example, psychoanalysis is an even greater swindle, and much of political science is bunk--sometimes dangerous to boot.

Why not enlarge the scope of SI to include all of the pseudosciences and pseudotechnologies?
