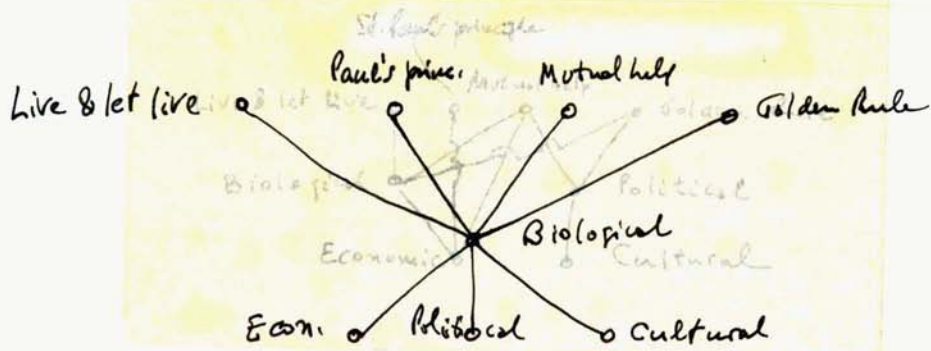


## QUATRIPARTITE MORAL CODE

Since every society is composed of a biological, an economic, a political and a cultural system, social behavior falls into at least one of these subsystems. Consequently moral rules are (predominantly) biological, economic, political, or cultural. Here the 'or' is inclusive, for some rules are social, i.e. they concern behavior in all four subsystems. Table . lists a few moral rules of all five kinds.
