

## AGGREGATION OF RIGHTS

Intuitively, the rights of different people cannot be aggregated into a single magnitude. However, the rights of a fixed kind can be aggregated if rights are defined in terms of basic needs. Example 1: the right to a minimum protein consumption of 35 grams per day per person adds up to 35 n g/day for a society composed of  $n$  individuals.
