

GOOD & RIGHT

There are three possible views on the relation between goodness and rightness:

1. There is no necessary relation: while some right actions have good consequences, others do not.
(utilitarianism)
2. Consequentialism: x is right iff it has good consequences.
3. Deontologicalism: right precedes good and can be evaluated in itself (independently of its consequences). E.g. Kant.

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
